




### responsabilities



This trail starts in the old Tree Nursery area, a pleasant wooded area with a picnic park next to the Âncora river. The trail ascends along the rivers bank, along a narrow mountain trail until you come to the Pilgrim and PR 1 trails. Start the descent to the S. Mamede chapel, the first church to be built in Montaria, where a monk from the S. João d'Arga monastery would come to celebrate mass on Sundays and other holy days – this explains its location half way up the mountain slope. Walkers should also admire the small fountain located to the right of the chapel. Head towards Pedrulhos, a charming location with rustic houses and water mills. You will be able to see a stone sun clock which is used to control the use of irrigation waters for each farmer. Continue towards the places of Trás--Âncora and Espantar, where walkers may visit the Espantar watermills. These have been fully restored. The mills, pathways and levadas indicate the strong connection the locals had with nature. From here hikers are able to admire Serra de Perre and the Santa Luzia Mount as well as the coastline of Vila Praia de Âncora, and in the background, Viana do Castelo. Head towards "Senhora do Socorro" chapel and then walk to the left bank of Âncora's river,
